

Hygiene at the UKBB

Information for patients



The infection prevention team at the UKBB deals with the prevention and control of infections in the hospital. Appropriate measures contribute directly to patient safety.

Please help to implement the recommended hygiene measures and thus protect your child and our and our patients in the best possible way.



Washing hands

Pathogens are often transmitted via the hands. Therefore, thorough hand hygiene is especially important when you are in hospital. Wash your hands with water and soap when you

- enter a patient's room.
- after changing diapers or escorting to the toilet.
- before preparing food.
- after going to the toilet.
- before eating.
- if your hands are visibly soiled.



Hygienic measures

- The patient bed and the entire patient room are cleaned daily.
 Please put away your personal belongings so that this work can be done thoroughly.
- We ask you to wipe the changing table with a damp disinfectant cloth after use.




Hand disinfection

In some cases, it is necessary for you to additionally disinfect your hands. Our staff will instruct you on how correct hand disinfection works.

Hand disinfection is required in the following situations:

- before touching your child or other patients
- before you leave the patient's room





Visitors with symptoms of illness

- If you, as the person accompanying your child, feel ill and/or have symptoms such as cough, cold or fever, please inform our nursing staff immediately.
- Sick siblings and other visitors should stay at home.
